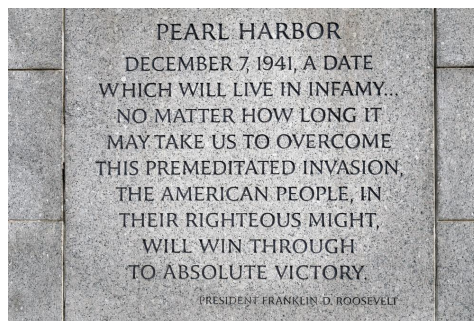


Appellate Court Update for November 2022
