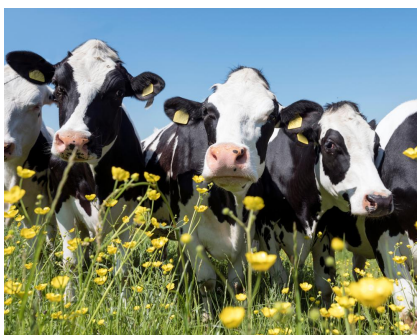
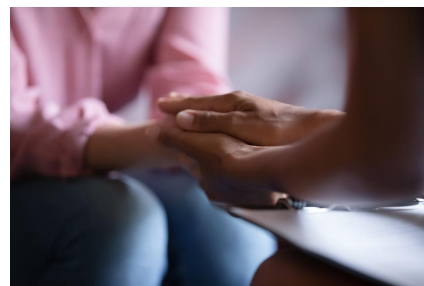


Purposeful Parenting Month
